

Analgesics you may consider using while taking an MAO-B inhibitor.

hydrocodone	Lortab [®] , Vicodin [®]
hydromorphone	Dilaudid [®] , Palladone [®]
ibuprofen	Advil [®] , Motrin [®] , Nuprin [®]
morphine	DepoDur [®] , Kadian [®] , MS Contin [®]
naproxen	Aleve [®] , Anaprox [®] , Naprosyn [®]
oxycodone	OxyContin [®] , Percocet [®] , Percodan [®]

All pain medicines should be used with caution. Many of these medicines have a variety of formulas and brand names that may not be listed here. There may be safety concerns with pain medicines that are not related to their use with MAO-B inhibitors.
